## What is Specialty Infusion doing to keep our patients and staff healthy?

- Our clinical staff has increased the rigor and frequency of cleaning and sanitizing of each site and frequently touched areas.
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer is available at check-in and throughout each site.
- Patients are screened for symptoms at check-in.
- All of our centers are closed centers. Only people with scheduled appointments are allowed to enter. Anyone with symptoms of

fever, cough, and shortness of breath are asked to please reschedule their appointment.

 We are minimizing all other exposures, as well as, deliveries to our sites and ensuring that deliveries be placed outside our sites only.

## What special considerations do people who are on an immunosuppressant need to keep in mind?

Generally speaking, patients who take medications that suppress their immune system are at increased risk for infection. However, there are preventive measures you can take to limit your exposure risk and help prevent spread of the virus. As per CDC recommendation, we encourage you to implement the following:

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol.
- Do not touch your nose, mouth, or eyes with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Say home if you are sick.

- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue or your elbow and wash your hands immediately after.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects.
